# WHAT IS PJVISION?

- PJVision is a new online system that PJR will be rolling out in stages starting in Q1 2026. The intent is that this system will eventually become the primary means of interface between PJR, our clients, and our auditors.
- Eventually – PJVision will be used for all of the following tasks:
  - Creation of the audit plan;
  - Creation of the audit report;
  - Management of the client's audit program;
  - Client complaint management; and
  - Client dispute management.


# WHAT FEATURES OF PJVISION WILL BE AVAILABLE IN THE INITIAL ROLLOUT?

- PJR has opted to take “baby steps” and limit what features will be initially available in PJVision. Those initial features will be as follows:
  - Issuance of NCRs, including client response to NCRs and provision of related evidence;
  - Management of audit related files (audit plan, audit report, etc.); and
  - Our internal review and approval process.
- In this way we feel strongly that users will have a chance to get comfortable with PJVision before more aggressive features are added.

# WHAT WILL (FOR NOW) NOT BE IN PJVISION?

- All other aspects of the audit package will continue to be prepared using the existing Microsoft Word documents, including:
  - Audit Plan
  - Audit Report

# ACCESSING PJVISION



# WHEN SHOULD I ACCESS PJVISION?


- PJVision is accessible to any PJR client at any time.
- As this is a new system we encourage you to login as soon as possible so that you have a chance to get oriented before you need to use it in the context of an audit.

# HOW WILL I ACCESS PJVISION?

- As prior indicated, PJVision is an online system. This means that you will have to be connected to the internet in order to use its features.
- The URL is

- You will use the same credentials you created when you set-up your access to the client portion on PJR's website.

# WHAT IF I'VE NEVER ACCESSED PJR'S ONLINE FEATURES?

- Simply click the “Forgot Password” prompt at the bottom of the page.



# AUTHENTICATION IS REQUIRED

- As part of PJR's overall program for ensuring the security of our networks and the intellectual property of our customers we have implemented a two factor authentication (2FA) process for all users accessing PJVision.
- The login screen encourages the use of Microsoft Authenticator to perform the authentication when you access PJVision.
  - Please note that any valid authentication software (2FAS, Google, etc.) can be used but in some cases there is a cost for such software. Microsoft Authenticator is free for users.
  - Please note that Microsoft Authenticator and all other reputable authentication apps can only be used on a smartphone.
- PJVision has been programmed to only request authentication once every 12 hours – so in all likelihood you'll only have to do it once per day.

# SETTING UP AUTHENTICATION THE FIRST TIME

- The first time you attempt to access PjVision you will be asked to enter your username and password as reviewed earlier in this presentation.
- PjVision will then have a window pop up similar to the one shown here and ask you to provide a “6 digit code” for authentication.




# USING MICROSOFT AUTHENTICATOR

# FUTURE VISITS TO PJVISION

- Once you've completed your first successful authentication login to PJVision all you'll need to do on future login attempts is pull out your smartphone and enter the 6 digit code that is generated.
- Once you've added PJVision to Microsoft Authenticator it does not have to be re-added – the codes will generate whenever you need them and can be entered in the provided space.




- Now you'll be able to access both the client portal on PJR's website as well as the new PJVision system.

# PJVISION HAS YOUR ENTIRE AUDIT HISTORY

- Because PJVision draws from the same system that we schedule our audits in – logging in gives you access to all past, current, and future audit information.

# PJVISION WILL HAVE ALL YOUR AUDIT FILES

- Have you ever wondered things like:
  - “Where’s my audit report from last year?”
  - “What were my NCRs last year?”
  - “Where’s my audit plan for this year?”
- Have you felt frustrated because you’re chasing your auditor or PJR for an email (that may not have even been sent to the right person?)
- PJVision aims to solve that problem by putting all relevant information at your fingertips. Starting in 2026 it will be the only place you’ll need to visit to get your audit plans, audit reports, NCRs, and other relevant information.

# ACCESSING YOUR AUDIT FILES ON PJVISION

- When you click on an audit that took place in 2026 or later you'll see a link titled "Files." You'll also see a button called "Non-Conformities" – we'll get back to that one.
- Simply click the "Files" link and you'll be able to download some or all of the available files.



# RESPONDING TO NCRS ISSUED IN PJVISION

- Starting March 16, 2026 our auditors will be using PJVision exclusively to create nonconformances for any audit being performed for the vast majority of our available certifications, including:
  - ISO 9001
  - R2v3
  - ISO 27001
  - ISO 14001
  - BA9000; and many others.
- The only exceptions to this will be in the following schemes:
  - AS9100;
  - AS9110;
  - AS9120; and
  - IATF 16949

# HOW DO I RESPOND TO AN NCR IN PJVISION?

- Begin by clicking the “Non-Conformities” button we showed you earlier, then click on the NCR number that appears on the far left.
- Please note that it’s status is always given at the far right – in this case “Customer Review” is indicated meaning that you have one or more steps to complete in the response.

# REVIEWING THE NCR – PART 1

- Near the top of the NCR view you'll find the audit number, NCR number, and the auditor that wrote the NCR.

# REVIEWING THE NCR – PART 2

- PJR follows the industry specified method in writing our NCRs and provides them in a three part fashion:
  - Statement of Finding (this is the overall systemic issue cited.)
  - Standard Requirement (this is the criteria (e.g. ISO 9001) that is being violated by the cited issue.
  - Objective Evidence (this is the “who, what, when, how” that was found during the audit.)

## Statement of Finding

Processes established to ensure that all product is inspected before release to customers are not fully effective at this time.

## Standard Requirement

8.6 Release of products and services

## Cite Specific Shall (optional)

## Other Requirements Not Met (optional)


Procedure XYZ123, Clause 4.5: "All products require inspection by the QC Department prior to shipment as recorded on QF 128HX"

## Objective Evidence

During a review of the production area, I noted two sealed boxes of AB-BN-14878 product that was manufactured under lot number 120425-AA. No record of inspection could be found for this part number tied to that lot number. It was verbally confirmed by the shipping supervisor and quality director that this was missed.

# ENTERING YOUR RESPONSE


- PJR again follows industry bylaws in requiring a four part response for every nonconformance. Those four parts are:
  - Correction
  - Extent Analysis
  - Root Cause Analysis
  - Corrective Action
- You will use the provided spaces within PJVision to provide each of these four pieces – including the effective date and the person(s) at your organization responsible for the response.
- PJVision also includes a feature where you can attach supporting evidence of your response.


# ADDING EVIDENCE FILES – PART 1

- Once you click the “Add Files” button you will have a window pop up. Simply navigate to the files on your computer and select “Open.”
- You can use the “Control” button on a windows PC to select and upload multiple files at once.



# ADDING EVIDENCE FILES – PART 2

- Once all files are queued up – you’ll simply click the “Save Changes” button on the right.



# ALL INFORMATION IS REQUIRED!

- As you input your response you will have the option to select “Save Changes” as seen on the last slide.
- PJVision has been programmed to alert you if there are any parts of your response that are missing as shown below.

# WHAT HAPPENS ONCE I CLICK “SAVE CHANGES”?

- Assuming you've entered all required information you'll receive a confirmation message from PJVision that the task has been successfully completed.
- Your NCR status will also update to “Auditor Review.”
- Once this happens you will be locked out of the NCR so that the auditor can complete their review.
- It's important to remember that auditors are constantly traveling and performing audits – a good rule of thumb is to allow 3-5 business days for the auditor to review your response and provide feedback.



# WHAT HAPPENS IF THE AUDITOR REJECTS ALL OR PART OF MY RESPONSE?


- An auditor rejection of a client response (in whole or in part) will result in the audit's status reverting back to "Open" in PJVision which you will be able to see in the "Audits" screen as prior discussed. You will also receive an automated email from the PJVision system indicating you need to login to address a concern.



# THE NON-CONFORMITY SCREEN

- The Non-Conformity Screen is a helpful resource that can be used to see all NCRs captured in PJVision at a glance (across multiple audits as applicable.)
- Please note the three possible statuses:
  - Customer Review – meaning that input from you (the client) is needed;
  - Auditor Review – meaning that your auditor still needs to review one or more of your responses;
  - Auditor Accepted – meaning that the nonconformity response is approved and closed.

- Look for the “Auditor Rejected” markers – and note the comments provided by the auditor.




# CONFIRMATION OF KEY DETAILS
