

Terminology




- MTPD Maximum Tolerable Period of Disruption
- RTO Recovery Time Objective
- RPO Recovery Point Objective (Maximum Data Loss)

Determining the MTPD and RTO

Biggest challenges with the BIA



- Top management acknowledging and supporting the implementation
- Establishing a common understanding/language between business and IT
- Getting all dependencies including on IT services
- Subjectivity it is necessary to assess the risks, losses and prioritize correctly
- Interviewing the organization and the administrative follow up




Conclusion
